#2. Anthropic blocks third-party use of Claude Code subscriptions

■ Build a compliant multi-provider coding-agent CLI + auth/billing layer for power users because vendors are shutting down subscription-token reuse and teams need reliable, cost-controlled access across models.

#3. Supabase hit \$5B by turning down million-dollar contracts. Here's why.

■ Build an enterprise governance + compliance layer for Supabase teams because Supabase is prioritizing product-led scale and declining bespoke \$1M+ enterprise demands, leaving security/procurement needs unmet.

#4. At least 80 new tech unicorns were minted in 2025 so far

■ Build an AI cost+quality control plane (SDK + dashboard) for teams shipping LangChain/agent apps because unicorn-level spend is exploding but day-2 governance (budgets, evals, audit trails) is still a bottleneck.

#5. AI is a business model stress test

- Build an SLO-backed managed ops layer (deploys, rollbacks, security patching, observability) for OSS devtool maintainers because AI is collapsing docs-driven discovery and commoditizing specifiable features.
